Fall Off-Season (September-December).

In the fall we meet Tuesdays & Thursdays from 6:30-9pm and select Saturdays from 10-3pm for robot modifications, workshops, fundraising, community outreach events, and off-season competitions:

Build Season (January-March)

During “build season” (January-March) we meet Mondays-Fridays from 6:30-9:30pm and Saturdays from 10am to 4pm to design, build, and program a robot for the current season’s game.

Competition Season (March-April)

During competition season (March-April) we meet anywhere between 2-5 days per week from 6:30-9pm with 2-4 weekend competitions thrown in the mix (see tentative competition schedule below) depending on how far we qualify.

Minimum Team Expectations:

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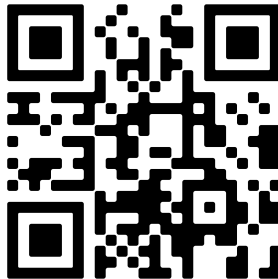
- Every student is invited to travel with the team to local events regardless of attendance and participation, however, you get what you put into the program

- To be qualified for the drive team and to be in the pit you must qualify for the travel team AND pass a knowledge check prior to competition season.
